Those present discussed the 83<sup>rd</sup> Ave project; the west ditch needs to be re-sloped in spring before the crops are planted and a layer of Class 5 needs to be put down before chloride in spring.

In regards to 135<sup>th</sup> St.; the road will be looked at this year to see if any work needs to be done in the 2018 to stabilize it for the work being done in 2019 in conjunction with Stearns County projects.

Those present discussed solar gardens. The City Council needs to decide what it wants for the City. The Township regulations currently fall under the County. Board member Wicker is interested to know if a garden is dormant or no longer producing could the entity require it to be removed at the developer's cost.

Mayor Konz discussed the Library Committee with those present and their progress on a new location for the Great River Regional Kimball Library Branch; Win-Go is willing to sell the property located at 51 Spruce Ave W to the City. The Friends of the Library have been fundraising.
