

City Council Work Session  
January 24, 2023

Work Session started at 5:30pm

Councilmembers present: Karla Davis, Steven Dahlager, Cindy Stelten and Jody Orbeck; Kyle Christensen arrived at 5:35pm

Others present: Chad Koren

The Council worked on points to be assigned for Pay Equity reporting for the Public Works Assistant (83) and Public Works Lead (118) positions and adjusted the Clerk/Treasurer (120.5) points as needed.

The Council discussed snow removal. Mayor Davis would like to see costs tracked for removal; this would help when compiling information for equipment costs for future spending vs. hiring contractors.

The Council discussed projects to be worked on. Councilmember Stelten would like to see an ongoing list of projects to be worked on: library dirt, library seeding, the park, etc.

Mayor Davis discussed having a park or beautification committee and getting a list compiled of what they would work on within the City and they could come up with ideas on how to fund projects.

Those present discussed the bathrooms at Willow Creek Park. Councilmember Christensen wants to know how much it costs to install the correct grinder pump.

In regards to the ballfield fencing, Councilmember Christensen has not been able to get and bids; contractors are not willing to provide a bid for insurance. They want to bid on work that will be done.

The Council looked at the banner ad from Northern Lights Display.

Councilmember Stelten stated that she contacted Carol Newman from the Historical Society regarding being on the next Council meeting agenda.
