

City Council Work Session
May 23, 2023

Work Session started at 5:45pm

Councilmembers present: Cindy Stelten, Jody Orbeck and Steven Dahlager; Karla Davis and Kyle Christensen absent

Others present: Carol Newman, Marilyn Sterling and Alice Robinson

Acting Mayor Cindy Stelten clarified and discussed the letter sent by the Historical Society to the City Council after meeting with Mayor Davis and herself on May 2nd. Their board discussed and would like the western 1/3 of the old library space (3 windows included and closest to the stage area), the northern half of the old stage area and the (soon to be) old City Office space.

Those present discussed putting together a long-term agreement for a space lease as was previously in place for the use of the space upstairs. The City Clerk and Alice Robinson discussed working on that.

Councilmember Orbeck asked who would be paying for the costs associated with this? There will need to be cost sharing. The City will work on getting estimates.

Carol explained that the listing put together of changes to be made was a wish list made by a member.

Items can start being moved the week after Kimball Days, that way the City can start working on the space in the winter.

This may possibly be discussed more at the June 27th workshop.
