

Special Meeting

June 16, 2020

Meeting called to order by Mayor Tammy Konz at 5:02pm

City Engineer, Dave Blommel, reviewed the MnDOT TH2021 Project with the Council. Councilmember Orbeck has concerns with any assessments that will be over \$10,000 and the road being narrowed. Dave explained that narrower roads will help to slow traffic down; the driving lanes will only be reduced by 1ft. each. Councilmember Christensen inquired about having the speed limit lowered. Dave explained that is not an option on a trunk highway. Those present discussed having an open house on August 18 from 4pm-6pm with MnDOT available to answer questions.
