

City Council Work Session

June 27, 2023

Work Session started at 5:31pm

Councilmembers present: Karla Davis, Cindy Stelten, Jody Orbeck, Steven Dahlager and Kyle Christensen

Introductions were made and Dennis explained that it had been some time since the Township and City had met; he had contacted Nicole to see what could be set up.

The Township is looking at their road maintenance schedule; as it pertains to the City, that would include 83<sup>rd</sup> Ave and 135<sup>th</sup> St. 83<sup>rd</sup> Ave has settled some where the sewer force main comes across. This road could use a complete mill and overlay from CR44 to Hwy 55. 135<sup>th</sup> St requires maintenance; blow patching, possibly yet this year.

The City Clerk inquired if the same process would be used as in the past; the Township bid out the projects and then billed the City? Yes, that is the plan.

Groups will meet again at a later date when more information is known.

Councilmember Stelten inquired about working together with the Township on the brush/compost site; currently it is for City residents only. This would allow Township residents to use it also.

Township Board Member Loewen also thought it a good idea to work together on Clean-up Day.

The City Clerk stated that is on September 23<sup>rd</sup> this year.

The remaining workshop items: Review Possible Nuisance Ordinance Revisions, Review Possible Parking Regulation Revisions, Review Possible Animal Ordinance Revisions to Allow Chickens in Residential Districts and Discuss the Budget will be discussed at the July 18<sup>th</sup> workshop at 5:30pm.
