

Minutes from August 17, 2015

There was much discussion after their presentation regarding the impact it would have on our other entities. Question were asked about class offerings and student graduation numbers.

The city of Kimball discussed the Maus drive project and the timeline on that with the starting of school. Mayor Konz also talked about the students coming to city hall with Mr. Stangles class and how much it is enjoyed by all.

Maine Prairie talked about their building and also the different school districts that their township has within their boundaries.
