

Special Meeting
September 9, 2014

Meeting called to order by Mayor Tammy Konz at 7:00pm

Those present discussed Maus Dr. – it was originally built in 1976 by Andy Maus for \$100,000 then turned over to the City. Additional road was built as parcels of property were sold; each property owner built themselves. Maus' have seal coated the road 2x from Hwy 55 to the entrance off of Hwy 15.

City Engineer Randy Sabart reviewed the feasibility study and the feasibility study amendment; costs estimated at \$613,284 and \$353,752 respectively. Roads have a typically life-span of 20 years. The feasibility study does not include a topographical survey with elevations; that would be done in the design phase. Mr. Sabart reviewed the assessment process and payback options; the City has historically assessed at 25% and Chapter 429 requires a minimum of 20%.
