

Special Meeting
September 26, 2019

Meeting called to order by Mayor Tammy Konz at 6:00pm

Others present: Dave Blommel, Brian Mehr, Chad Koren, Chuck Yanish, Linda Yanish, Steve Smith, Mark Magnuson, Sherman Minter, Jerry Albert and Joe Druga

City Engineer, Dave Blommel, explained for those present that the City had been approached by a few property owners about connecting to City water and sewer.

Chuck and Linda Yanish stated that they are not looking at developing their property.

The representatives from Kimball Christian Church will be adding a 10,000 sq. ft. addition to their current facility; thus, their inquiry about connecting to City sewer (they are already connected to City water).

The City Clerk will send letters to the property owners along Hazel Ave W and Hwy 55 W that did not attend to inform them that the City needs to know prior to the October 14th Council meeting if they are interested in connecting to City water and sewer.

Dave discussed phasing in the Water Treatment Plant project with the Council. The project was initially proposed for early 2020 with a total cost of \$297,212. Phasing the project in through 2024 would have a total cost of \$370,000. The Council will discuss this at their next meeting on October 1st.
