Winter Parking Reminder



Winter Parking Reminder - No person shall park a vehicle upon any street in the City between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., on any date that falls between 12:01 a.m. November 1st and 11:59 p.m. April 30th of the following year. The City of Kimball may, in its sole discretion, tow any vehicle parked in violation of this section to an impound lot. The cost of the tow and impound fee shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle prior to the vehicle being released from impound.

Running Water:

If City Hall has not contacted you to stop running your water, you are now able to turn the water off.

To prevent the service line from freezing, due to lower temperatures of the water, residents were asked to keep a faucet flowing. A price adjustment will be reflected in the dollar amount charged for the water and sewer service directly.

It WILL NOT be shown in the gallon amounts that are displayed on your bill, you will only see the dollar amount has been lowered. So do NOT be alarmed when you see the high usage in gallons. Please contact City Hall if there are any questions.
