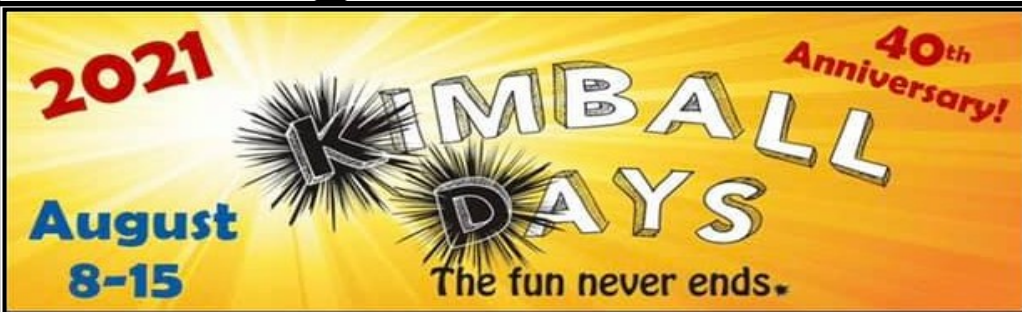

Back to School Safety

As children start heading back to school, family life can get pretty hectic. It's important to remember - and share with your children - some key tips that will help keep them safe and healthy throughout the year.

Transportation Safety - Whether children walk, ride their bicycle or take the bus to school, it is extremely important that they take proper safety precautions. Here are some tips to make sure your child safely travels to school:

Walking to School

- ✓ **Review your family's walking safety rules and practice walking to school with your child.**
 - Walk on the sidewalk, if one is available; when on a street with no sidewalk, walk facing traffic.
 - Before you cross the street, stop and look left, right and left again to see if cars are coming.
 - Make eye contact with drivers before crossing and always cross streets at crosswalks or intersections.
 - Stay alert and avoid distracted walking.

Riding a bicycle to School

- ✓ **Teach your child the rules of the road and practice riding the bike to school with your child.**
 - Ride on the right side of the road, with traffic, and in single file.
 - Come to a complete stop before crossing the street; walk bikes across the street.
 - Stay alert and avoid distracted riding.
 - Make sure your child always wears a properly fitted helmet and bright clothing.

Riding the bus to School

- ✓ **Teach your children school bus safety rules and practice with them.**
 - Go to the bus stop with your child to teach them the proper way to get on and off the bus.
 - Teach your child to stand six feet (or 3 giant steps) away from the curb.
 - If your child must cross the street in front of the bus, teach him or her to walk on the side of the road until they are 10 feet ahead of the bus; your child and the bus driver should always be able to see each other.

Driving your child to School

- ✓ **Stay alert and avoid distracted driving.**
 - Obey school zone speed limits and follow your school's drop-off procedure.
 - Make eye contact with children who are crossing the street.
 - Never pass a bus loading or unloading children.
 - The area 10 feet around a school bus is the most dangerous for children; stop far enough back to allow them to safely enter and exit the bus.
