Utility Rate Adjustment

At their December 18, 2018, meeting the City Council enacted a rate increase that will become effective with usage starting January 1st. (you will see change on February bill).

Sewer Rates:	
Base Rate (minimum charge) includes first 1,000 gallons	\$28.50
Additional Units (duplexes, apartments, etc..) minimum charge per un-metered unit	\$8.00
Charge for each 1,000 gallons over the base rate	\$3.50
Un-metered Units	\$28.50

Water Rates:	
Base Rate (minimum charge) includes first 1,000 gallons	\$27.00
Additional Units (duplexes, apartments, etc..) minimum charge per un-metered unit	\$8.00
Charge for each 1,000 gallons over the base rate	\$3.50
Un-metered Units	\$27.00

Refuse & Recycling Service

Here are some important things to remember:

URGENT NOTICE REGARDING YOUR WATER SERVICE

The City of Kimball is recommending that all residents and businesses that are connected to the City water supply take the temperature of their water. If the temperature of your water is below 40 degrees, you should let your water run at a continuous stream about the size of a pencil or pinkie finger width. The City is being proactive due to the extremely cold temperatures being predicted. At this time, we **HAVE NOT** been notified of any water services that have already frozen. However, leaving your water run can help to prevent this from happening. **You MUST contact City Hall in order to receive credit for leaving your water running.**

A pencil sized stream amounts to approximately 1/4 gallon of water per minute (10,800 gallons per month) per connection. Please continue to monitor the temperature of your water even after the cold spell.

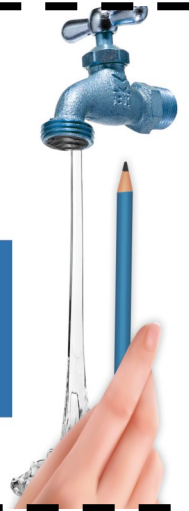

(WIDTH OF A #2 PENCIL)

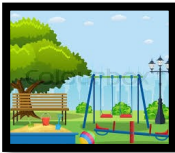


Severe Weather Reminders

Please remember all snow & ice needs to be removed from public sidewalks within 24 hours after the precipitation has ceased to fall. It is the property owners responsibility to clear the abutting sidewalk to their property. If your sidewalk is not cleared within allowed amount of time, the City will follow the abatement process.

Snow Plowing & Ice Control Policy: Snow accumulation must be over 2 inches before the plowing operation begins. Priority streets are plowed first. The sand and salt mixture will be minimized to certain areas. When cleaning snow off of private property, **DO NOT** push snow onto the street or on to another property. This is a violation of MN Statute 160.2715. Any one violation this statute will be guilty of a misdemeanor. Cleaning adjacent to mailboxes is the resident's responsibility. The city will get as close to the curb as possible.

Winter Parking Reminder: No person shall park a vehicle upon any street in the City between the hours of 10pm & 6am, on any date that falls between Nov. 1 (12:00 am) and April 30th (11:59 pm) the following year. The city of Kimball may, in it's sole discretion, tow any vehicle parked in violation of this section to an impound lot. The cost of the tow and impound fee shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle prior to the vehicle being released from impound. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

Don't forget to License your Dog!

All dogs 6 months of age and older must be licensed annually and shall wear a dog tag. Bring or mail the following to City Hall:

- ⇒ Proof of rabies vaccination
- ⇒ \$10.00 Licensing Fee (after February 15th the fee is \$30)
