New Garbage Service

Our garbage service recently changed to VEOLIA and we hope the transition has been smooth. Here are some important changes to remember that will be occurring with your service since the change in providers.

1. Pick up will be on **MONDAYS**
2. Carts need to be out and on the curb by 7 AM
3. Recycling will remain every other week—please refer to the calendar you received in your December statement. If you need a new copy they are available at City Hall.
4. Extra trash collection needs—contact VEOLIA directly.
EXAMPLES
 - A. Extra trash bags that don't fit into your cart
 - B. Large Items - furniture, mattress, doors, grill, etc.

Dog License Renewal

All dogs 6 months of age and older must be licensed annually and shall wear a dog tag. Licenses must be renewed at City Hall by January 1, of each year. You must bring along the following:

- Proof/certificate of recent rabies vaccination
- \$10.00 Licensing fee (**reminder after Feb. 15 the fee is \$30**)

REMINDERS:

- No dog shall be permitted to run at large within the limits of the City. All dogs out of doors on an owner's premises shall be kept in a kennel or on a leash. The requirement of kenneling may be met by keeping the dog inside an area enclosed by a fence of sufficient strength and height to prevent the dog from escaping the fenced area or running at large.

- If a dog is found to be running at large by the Animal Control Officer; is licensed and wearing a Current City Dog Tag, the dog shall be returned to the owner the first time upon receipt of payment as set forth in the Schedule of Fees. If the owner is not at home to receive the dog, the dog shall be placed in a dog pound designated by the Council. Any dog determined to be a Potentially Dangerous or Dangerous Dog will be immediately taken to a pound designated by the Council. Any dog found to be running at large by the Animal Control Officer which is unlicensed by the City of Kimball or has been previously picked up and returned to its owner, shall be placed in a dog pound designated by the Council.

Building Permits

Planning on doing some projects around your house this winter or spring make sure to check with city hall before you start any work to verify whether or not you need a permit. Here is a list of some basic projects, but always call City Hall to verify before you start any work.

“What things do I need a permit for?”

- Re-roofing
- Re-siding
- Replacing Windows/Doors
- Accessory Buildings (shed/garage)
- Fence
- Driveway/Slab
- Mechanical
- Plumbing
- Decks
- Finishing a basement/Remodel
- Retaining walls exceed 4ft.
- Demolition
- Additions
- Other

All permits need to be obtained before you start work. An investigation fee, in addition to the permit fee, shall be collected whenever any work for which a permit is required has been commenced without first obtaining a permit.

Severe Weather Reminders

Winter Sidewalk Cleaning

Please remember all snow and ice needs to be removed from public sidewalks within 24 hours after the precipitation has ceased to fall.

It is the property owners responsibility to clear the abutting sidewalk to their property. If your sidewalk isn't cleared within the allowed amount of time, the City will follow the abatement process.

Snow Plowing & Ice Control Policy

Snow accumulation must be over 2 inches before the plowing operation begins.

Priority streets are plowed first. The sand and salt mixture will be minimized to certain areas.

When cleaning snow off of private property, **DO NOT** push snow onto the street or on to another property. This is a violation of MN Statute

160.2715. Any one violating this statute will be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Cleaning adjacent to mailboxes is the resident's responsibility. The city will get as close to the curb as possible.

Mail box front should be placed 6 inches behind curb.

Winter Parking Reminder

We would like to remind the City residents of the winter parking ordinances

Restrictions—515.01

No person shall park a vehicle upon any street in the City between the hours of 10:00 pm – 6:00 am, on any date that falls between Nov. 1 (12:01 am) and April 30th (11:59 pm) the following year.

Towing Vehicles - 515.02

The City of Kimball may, in it's sole

discretion, tow any vehicle parked in violation of this section to an impound lot. The cost of the tow and impound fee shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle prior to the vehicle being released from the impound.

Penalty - 515.03

Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor. It should be noted the fine amount for a vehicle parked in violation of this section is \$30.
