A Reminder on "Public Nuisances"

With the summer months here and people out and about, complaints on public nuisance problems become a bigger concern for residents and their neighborhood. In the next few weeks letters will be sent to property owners who are in violation, notifying them of the violation and asking them to correct the situation. City Ordinance 400 deals with nuisances. Residents and business owners should know these ordinances to avoid public nuisance complaints. Common nuisance complaints received by the City are: junk in yards including but not limited to household appliances, automobile bodies, trash and debris situated in a manner as to constitute a fire, health or safety hazard; garbage cans left on a sidewalk for longer than 24 hours after pick-up day; noxious weeds such as Canadian thistle; grass longer than 8"; placing and/or throwing glass, nails or other items which may injure any person, animal or vehicle passing over the item; inoperable and/or unlicensed motor vehicles; animal feces that owners do not pick up in the public right-of-way and any dog that repeatedly and habitually barks, howls, bays or whines. Residents should also be aware of the fact that during construction or repair of property, building materials should be stacked or stored in a neat and orderly fashion and in a manner so as to avoid presenting any danger to the general public. The city is authorized to abate the nuisance of not remedied by the deadline given to a property owner. All costs of abatement are the responsibility of the property owner.

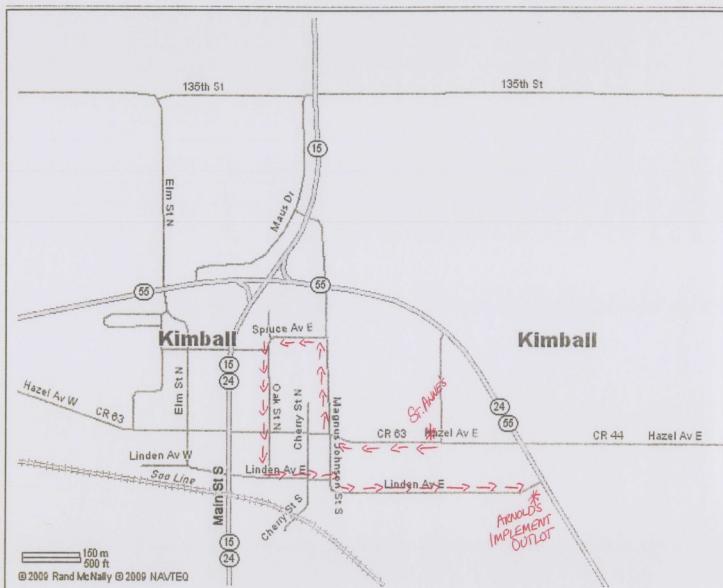

Brush and Compost Pick-Up

Tuesday Mornings— All brush and compost must be placed at the curb by 6:30am.

Rules to follow:

- ⊗ Brush not to exceed 4 feet in length & must be bundled and tied.
- ⊗ Compost not to exceed 50 lbs. **ONLY** corn-based self-composting bags will be picked up. Compostable bags are distinct from regular plastic bags because they are usually clear or green-tinted opaque color. Most home improvement, grocery and hard-ware stores now carry them. If you don't see them, ask an employee at the store.

Just a friendly reminder... utility bills are due the 28th of each month. Payments can be made at the city office during business hours, placed in the drop slot, mailed or pay online (follow the links on the City of Kimball website). The City of Kimball also accepts credit cards in person and over the phone. No payment, no service.
