## March can still bring wintry weather!

### Severe Weather Reminders



Please remember all snow and ice needs to be removed from public sidewalks within 24 hours after the precipitation has ceased to fall. It is the property owners responsibility to clear the abutting sidewalk to their property. If your sidewalk is not cleared within the allowed amount of time, the City will follow the abatement process.

**Snow Plowing & Ice Control Policy:** Snow accumulation must be over 2 inches before the plowing operation begins. Priority streets are plowed first. The sand and salt mixture will be minimized to certain areas. When cleaning snow off of private property, **DO NOT** push snow onto the street or on to another property. This is a violation of MN Statute 160.2715. Any one violating this statute will be guilty of a misdemeanor. Cleaning adjacent to mailboxes is the resident's responsibility. The city will get as close to the curb as possible.

## MOVE OVER FOR FLASHING LIGHTS. IT'S THE LAW.

- When traveling on a lane with two or more lanes, you must keep over one full lane way from stopped emergency vehicles with flashing lights activated—ambulance, fire, law enforcement, maintenance and construction vehicles.
- Reduce speed if you are unable to safely move over a lane.
- Failing to take these actions endangers personnel who provide critical and life-saving services. Fines can exceed \$100.
