At their February meeting, the City Council updated the City's Utility Billing Policy. Starting March 2022, utility bills will now be due on the 25th of each month instead of the 28th. We will no longer be disconnecting delinquent accounts that are 1 month past due. Delinquent accounts will be sent a disconnect notice once their past due balance reaches \$250 or more and is not paid on or before the due date.

The new due date will be implemented over the next 3 months. This will allow residents time to get used to the change and update any auto-payments they have set up. If you set up your auto-payment directly at City Hall please contact the City Clerk to see if the date needs to be changed.

An Update on Clean-up Day

Historically, the City has held clean-up day the 1st Saturday in May. Due to the availability of Stearns County Household Hazardous Waste, Mother's Day and opening fishing; that will be changing this year.

The 2022 date for clean-up day is September 24th. It will still be from 8am-11am and held in the parking lot area just to the east of A.M. Maus & Son.

If you have received a notice from City Hall regarding running your water due to the temperature to prevent your service line that goes to the City's water main from freezing, a price adjustment will be reflected in the dollar amount charged for the water and sewer service directly. It WILL NOT be shown in the gallon amounts that are shown on your bill.

We will contact you to notify you when the temperature of the water in your service line has reached a safe temperature that you no longer need to run it at a trickle
