## Willow Creek Park

If you are new to town we want to make it be known that we have a couple beautiful parks within the City's limits. Willow Creek is located to the South of the railroad tracks in Kimball. It is bordered by Highway 15, the Canadian Pacific Railroad Tracks and Maine Prairie Township.

The park totals 22.5 acres and offers the following amenities.

- Baseball Field—Maintained by the Kimball Express Town Team
- Kimball Lions Picnic Shelter—A fully enclosed shelter with a kitchen area (Open May 1st—October 15th, subject to weather)
- 9-hole Disc Golf Course
- Playground
- Nature Trails—which have been recently updated with maps
- Outdoor Picnic Areas
- Willow Creek—A trout stream that runs the length of the park and is regularly stocked with Brown Trout by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources; it also maintains some natural reproduction

- Heritage Park—Located to the North of the Fire Hall located West of Elm St N there is a kids playground
- Scheeler Addition Playground – Located in the new addition on the backside and East of Arnold's there is a kids playground
