**Compost Site:**

**The compost site is currently open.**

Public works will keep an eye on the site, so please make sure we are respectful and place only acceptable items within the area. We may have to close again due to inclement weather and road conditions being bad, make sure to watch for signs while entering.

**Brush & Compost Pick-Up**

**Starts April 30th & Ends October 29th**

Tuesday Mornings: All brush/compost must be placed at the curb by 6:30am.

Rules to follow:

- ⇒ Brush not to exceed 4 feet in length & it must be bundled and tied.
- ⇒ Compost not to exceed 50 lbs. **ONLY** corn-based self-composting bags will be picked up. Compostable bags are distinct from regular plastic bags because they are usually clear or green-tinted opaque color. Most home improvement, grocery and hardware stores now carry them. If you don't see them, ask an employee at the store.

- ⇒ **Biodegradable bags and Regular Garbage bags are NOT accepted and will NOT be picked up!**
- ⇒ **COMPOSTABLE BAGS ONLY!**
- ⇒ **CITY HALL HAS SOME AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE FOR ALL RESIDENTS—JUST STOP IN!**



**Clean Up Day REMINDER:**

Historically, the city has held Clean-up day the 1st Saturday in May. Starting in 2022 due to availability we changed the date to September.

**The Clean-up day for 2024 is September 21st.**

# PSN Mobile App



On March 26, 2024, we're removing the ability to download the Payment Service Network (PSN) mobile app. Any customers who already have the app downloaded can continue to use it, but PSN will no longer support new downloads.

This change **does not** impact your customer's ability to make payments using a mobile device. We've invested in optimizing PSN payment options for mobile devices and our web pages automatically adapt to any mobile or tablet device.

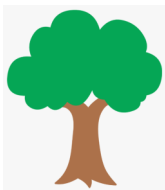
