### Compost Site:

**The compost site is currently open.**

Public works will keep an eye on the site, so please make sure we are respectful and place only acceptable items within the area. We may close again due to inclement weather and road conditions being bad, make sure to watch for signs while entering.

### Brush & Compost Pick-Up

**Starts May 6th & Ends October 28th**

Tuesday Mornings: All brush/compost must be placed at the curb by 6:30am. Rules to follow:

- ⇒ Brush not to exceed 4 feet in length & it must be bundled and tied.
- ⇒ Compost not to exceed 50 lbs. **ONLY** corn-based self-composting bags will be picked up. Compostable bags are distinct from regular plastic bags because they are usually clear or green-tinted opaque color. Most home improvement, grocery and hardware stores now carry them. If you don't see them, ask an employee at the store.
- ⇒ **Biodegradable bags and Regular Garbage bags are NOT accepted and will NOT be picked up!**
- ⇒ **COMPOSTABLE BAGS ONLY!**
- ⇒ **CITY HALL HAS SOME AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE FOR ALL RESIDENTS—JUST STOP IN!**

West Central has contacted the City multiple times stating that there are repeat offenders for residents with overflow garbage and/or recycling.



In our contract it states "Residential units needing additional service, for waste or recycling that does not fit in their container, may order additional containers. The monthly fee per each additional 65 gallon waste cart, serviced weekly shall be Eleven Dollars and Fifty cents (\$11.50). The monthly fee per each additional recycling cart, serviced every other week, shall be Six Dollars (\$6.00).

If you feel you are in need of an additional bin, please reach out to City Hall with that request and we can get that set up and delivered for you.

## **Running Water:**

If City Hall has not contacted you to stop running your water, you are now able to turn the water off.

Maps will be posted to both the City of Kimball and Kimball Area Chamber Facebook pages by Wednesday, May 7th—so be sure to reach out before then. There will also be printed maps at Casey's in town.

With spring/summer upon us, we want to send a friendly reminder about the City of Kimball's watering restriction that were put into effect.

### **Guidelines to follow:**

Lawn watering and irrigation of athletic fields will be limited to all properties based on address numbers. Addresses ending in an odd number can water lawns on Tuesday and addresses ending in an even number can water lawns on Wednesday. This action was taken to reduce peak water usage in areas served by the City's system.

- ◆ Additionally, because of how much water is lost to evaporation, watering is only permitted between 4 a.m. and 8 a.m.
- ◆ Watering of newly sodded or seeded yards is exempt from the odd and even day restriction for two weeks.
- ◆ Activities such as car washing, water toys and filling small kiddie swimming pools are exempt.
- ◆ Hand watering of newly planted trees, flowerpots, baskets, and vegetable gardens is permitted at any time.
- ◆ Any sprinkler system not served by the City's system is exempt.

These restrictions will be in effect until further notice.

PLEASE do your part in conserving water: look for leaks, consider an upgrade to WaterSense labeled products, take a sprinkler break and reuse water.
