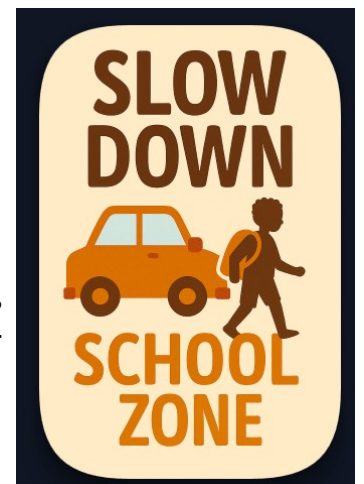
- The front entrance of City Hall is officially OPEN—thank you for your patience as we wrapped up construction!

### Snow Removal Policy

Snow accumulation must be over 2 inches before the City will commence plowing operations. Priority streets are plowed first. The sand and salt mixture will be minimized to certain areas. Cleaning adjacent to and in front of mailboxes is the resident's responsibility.

**If you have a fire hydrant near your residence, please help keep it free from snow. In case of a fire this could save your house or your neighbors.**

### Winter Parking Reminder

No person shall park a vehicle upon any street in the City between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., on any date that falls between 12:01 a.m. November 1st and 11:59 p.m. April 30st of the following year. The City of Kimball may, in its sole discretion, tow any vehicle parked in violation of this section to an impound lot. The cost of the tow and impound fee shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle prior to the vehicle being released from impound.



## Great News! Text Notifications Feature

PSN now offers **text notifications for eBills**—giving your payers instant access to billing info and a fast, convenient way to pay, all from a single message.

### What's changing?

- Starting **October 29th**, your account will be automatically activated for this feature.
- Your payers will have the ability to enroll in text notifications for their eBills.
- Once enrolled, with just a tap, your payer can view their balance and make a payment directly from their mobile device.

### Important details:

- Payers are **not** automatically enrolled. They will see the new option in their profile and can choose to sign up at any time.
- Payers will continue to receive eBill **email notifications** in addition to any text notifications.
- **No action is required on your part** — this feature is already included in your current PSN configuration, with **no additional setup or fees.**

### Sidewalk Cleaning

Please keep in mind that sidewalks need to be cleared within 48 hours after a snow and/or ice event. It is the property owner's responsibility to clear the abutting sidewalk to their property. If your sidewalk isn't cleared within the allowed amount of time, the city will follow the abatement process. This means the City will clear your sidewalk for you and send you a bill.
