Message From Public Works:

The last day for Brush & Compost Pick Up is Tuesday, November 6th!

RULES TO FOLLOW:

- Pickup is scheduled on Tuesday mornings.
- Brush not to exceed 4 feet in length & must be bundled and tied.
- Compost, not to exceed 50 lbs. ONLY Corn-based self composting bags will be picked up or containers approved by the Public works department. Compostable bags are distinct from regular plastic bags because they are usually clear or a green-tinted opaque color. Most home improvement, grocery and hardware stores now carry them. If you don't see them ask an employee.
- **NO Biodegradable bags.**
- **COMPOSTABLE BAGS ONLY.**
- To assure your brush/compost is picked up have on the curb **by 6:30 am.**

Winter Sidewalk Cleaning

Please remember all snow and ice needs to be removed from public sidewalks within 24 hours after the precipitation has ceased to fall.

It is the property owners responsibility to clear the abutting sidewalk to their property. If your sidewalk isn't cleared within the allowed amount of time, the City will follow the abatement process.

Snow Plowing & Ice Control Policy

Snow accumulation must be over 2 inches before the plowing operation begins.

Priority streets are plowed first. The sand and salt mixture will be minimized to certain areas.

When cleaning snow off of private property, **DO NOT** push snow onto the street or on to another property.

This is a violation of MN Statute 160.2715. Any one violating this statute will be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Cleaning adjacent to mailboxes is the resident's responsibility. The city will get as close to the curb as possible.

Mail box front should be placed 6 inches behind curb.

Winter Parking Reminder

We would like to remind the City residents of the winter parking ordinances

Restrictions - 515.01

No person shall park a vehicle upon any street in the City between the hours of 10:00 pm – 6:00 am, on any date that falls between Nov. 1 (12:01 am) and April 30th (11:59 pm) the following year.

Towing Vehicles - 515.02

The City of Kimball may, in it's sole discretion, tow any vehicle parked in violation of this section to an impound lot. The cost of the tow and impound fee shall be paid by the owner of the vehicle prior to the vehicle being released from the impound.

Penalty - 515.03

Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor. It should be noted the fine amount for a vehicle parked in violation of this section is \$30.
