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CHAPTER 3 DEPARTMENTS

ORDINANCE 305 POLICE DEPARTMENT

Section 305.01: CONTINUATION OF POLICE DEPARTMENT. This Section is intended to provide for the continuation of a police department and to establish rules regulating the same. The department shall consist of a Chief of Police and such additional members and employees of the police department as may be determined by the council from time to time.

Section 305.02: POLICE CHIEF. The head of the department shall be known as the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police shall have overall supervision and management of the police department and custody of all property used and maintained for purposes of the department.

Section 305.03: MAYOR'S AUTHORITY. The Mayor shall have, without the approval of the Council, authority to appoint additional members of the police department for temporary duty whenever, in the Mayor's judgment, an emergency exists for the preservation of life or property.

Section 305.04: AUTHORITY OF POLICE OFFICERS. The Chief of Police and all members of the police department shall have the powers and authority of peace officers generally and shall perform such duties as are required of them by the council or by law.

Section 305.05: POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICIES. The Council may, from time to time, establish, revise and amend policies relating to the police department.
