CHAPTER 4 PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE

ORDINANCE 425 JUNK VEHICLES

Section 425.01: REGULATION OF JUNK VEHICLES. No person shall abandon or store a junk vehicle within the City of Kimball, on private or public property, unless stored within an enclosed structure. Any junk vehicle abandoned or stored in violation of this ordinance shall be towed and impounded by the Kimball Police Department at the expense of the last registered owner.

Section 425.02: DEFINITION OF JUNK VEHICLE. “Junk Vehicle” shall mean any vehicle which is not in operable condition, or which is wholly or partly dismantled, or which is used for the sale of parts or kept for scrapping, dismantling or salvage of any kind, or which is not properly licensed for current operation within the State of Minnesota.

Section 425.03: LIMITATION ON VEHICLES. No person shall keep or store on public or private property, within the City of Kimball, more than the maximum permissible number of vehicles allowed by this Chapter. In districts zoned “Residential,” the maximum permissible number of vehicles shall be two per licensed driver residing in each dwelling unit on the property, to a maximum of four vehicles, not counting Collector Cars.

Section 425.04: COLLECTOR CARS. Collector cars shall not be counted in determining the number of vehicles, or determining junk vehicles. “Collector cars” shall mean any vehicle, whether operable or not:

- (1) for which the State of Minnesota has issued a Pioneer, Classic, Collector, or Street Rod license; or which bears original license plates in accordance with Minnesota law; AND
- (2) which is stored in a garage, enclosed structure, or is completely covered by a covering specifically designed and manufactured for the purpose of covering vehicles.

Section 425.05: LIMITATION. In districts zoned “Residential,” the maximum permissible number of vehicles, including Collector cars, shall be six.

Section 425.06: PENALTY. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
