CHAPTER 5 PUBLIC SAFETY

ORDINANCE 507 ELECTRONICALLY AMPLIFIED SOUND FROM MOTOR VEHICLES

Section 507.01: VEHICLES NOISE LIMITS FROM ELECTRONICALLY AMPLIFIED SOUND. No motor vehicle, upon any public or private property within the City of Kimball, shall emit any electronically amplified sounds that are plainly audible at a distance of 50 feet from the vehicle, provided that this section shall not apply to:

1. sirens, horns or other signaling devices used by an authorized emergency vehicle as defined in Minnesota Statutes Section 169.01;
2. vehicles in parades or other civic celebrations duly authorized by the City;
3. motor vehicle horns when actually used as a warning of danger;
4. anti-theft devices installed on motor vehicles.

Section 507.02: PENALTY. A violation of this section is punishable by a fine as set forth in the Schedule of Fees, Section 215.
