ORDINANCE 825 SEPTIC TANK ORDINANCE

Section 825.01: ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. The Septic Tank Ordinance prepared by the County of Stearns regulating the installation, construction, alteration, extension, repair and maintenance of individual sewage disposal systems; requiring permits for, and licensing of persons engaged in the construction thereof; providing for inspection, and prescribing penalties and amendments thereto, which code is known as the Septic Tank Ordinance, is in its entirety hereby adopted by the City by reference.

Section 825.02: USE PROHIBITED. No person shall use a septic tank, drainfield, mound, or other on-site sewage disposal system on any property in the City which has City sanitary sewer service available in an adjoining street, alley, or right-of-way. If such service is available, or becomes available, the owner of the property shall immediately discontinue use of the on-site disposal system and shall connect to City sewer at the owner's expense. If the owner shall fail to connect within a reasonable time after sewer service becomes available, continued use of the on-site disposal system shall be deemed a public nuisance and maybe abated by the City in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 400.
