CHAPTER 9 PUBLIC PROPERTY

ORDINANCE 910 WOOD CUTTING

Section 910.01: WOOD CUTTING. No person shall cut or trim any living or dead tree or wood on any property owned or occupied by the City of Kimball, except as herein provided.

Section 910.02: CITY MAY CUT. Employees, contractors, or licensees of the City of Kimball may cut or trim living or dead trees or wood on City property in the normal course of their duties but shall not cut or trim any living or dead trees or wood on City property on their own time nor for private use or gain.

Section 910.03: LICENSES TO CUT. The City Council may assign employees, hire contractors, or grant written licenses to cut or trim trees or wood on such terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by the Council.

Section 910.04: PENALTIES. Each violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor. Each day on which an unlawful cutting or trimming occurs shall be a separate offense.
